



Education.

Education is key to helping our clients build a life in the United States. We offer English Language Learning, citizenship preparation, and computer skills courses for adults. Our afterschool, summer, and cultural exchange programs offer children an avenue for extra help with coursework, college prep, and social adjustment.

Employment.

The Employment Program assists clients with the job search and placement process. Services include skills inventories, job application assistance, resume building, interview preparation, job placement, and follow-up.

Resettlement.

When clients first arrive, we help meet their immediate needs. These include finding and furnishing their new home, scheduling initial medical screenings, and enrolling children in school. Through our Reception and Placement Program, Match Grant, Refugee Cash Assistance, Refugee Medical Assistance, and Refugee Social Services programs, we support clients as they break down the barriers to self-sufficiency.

Health.

Participants enrolled in the health program may receive services such as healthy cooking classes, yoga and fitness classes, health screenings, and intensive medical case management.

Immigration.

Our goal is to enable our clients to effectively and efficiently transition to life in Tennessee. Our staff services include notary public, Board of Immigrant Appeals Accredited Staff, completing and filing immigration forms, and providing interpretation, consultation services, and immigration case follow-up.

Rise.

RISE (Refugee Integration Support and Empowerment) assists in the integration of refugees into the Nashville community by eliminating the barriers to employment through the following components: Childcare Training, Pre-Driving Classes, English Classes and Degree Accreditation
